Last year, I noticed a couple leaving their ultrasound appointment. They seemed overwhelmed. As it turns out, they had just learned they were having twins. The couple was experiencing a mix of both joy and fear — a feeling I remember so vividly from when I learned I was having twins two years ago.

In my role as executive director, I don't often get the chance to be with women and families face to face in the same way that our nurses and client advocates do. My work focuses on carrying out strategic initiatives and ensuring our staff has the support and resources they need to care for the women who come to AlphaCare. So when this happened, it felt a bit like a divine appointment. "I completely understand where you're coming from," I told them, "I went through the same experience." Through shared tears and words, I felt fortunate to be able to offer encouragement and prayer and to connect with this woman.

Before they left, the woman said to her partner, "I'm so glad we came here first.

This was the best place to discover this news." They then turned to me and said,

"You need to know you have the best staff here. We had such a fantastic experience from the moment we stepped foot in here."

When I reflect on the past year and AlphaCare's 2024 statistics, this moment sticks out to me. Not only does it make me feel so proud of our staff who provide such excellent, compassionate care to women every day—but it makes me remember this:

Every number has a story behind it.

And for each of those stories, the Lord has given AlphaCare the opportunity to play a vital role. We thank Him for allowing AlphaCare to be a place of hope and encouragement, and we pray that God continues to work in their unfolding lives, protecting them, strengthening them, and revealing His love and grace.
